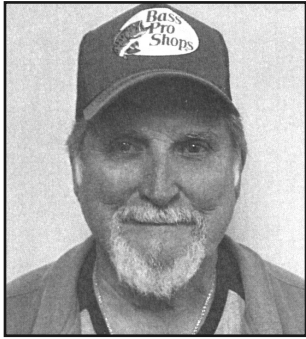

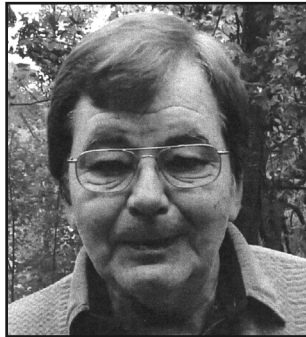
George Alsip

I believe that with my past experience and the length of time I have been a property owner, I would represent the needs and wishes of this community, to move forward while preserving the lake we love.

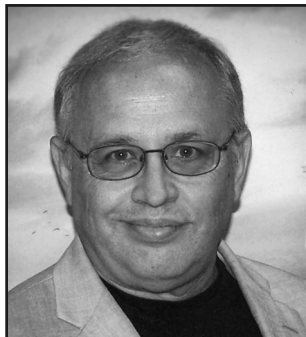


Bob Edwards

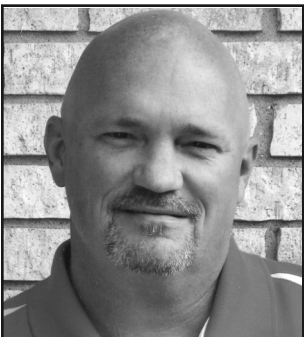
